



### Military Vehicles

Military vehicles have plates with up to five white numerals preceded by the insignia of the service (Diagram 5); the colour of the plate is red for the Army, light blue for the Air Force and dark blue for the Navy. Civil Defence vehicles have royal blue plates with five yellow numerals preceded by the letters CF.

### The Royal Family

The official cars of the King of Denmark bear only the royal crown in a white ground; cars belonging to other members of the royal family have plates with the royal crown followed by a serial number.

### Trade Plates

Plates for motor vehicle traders are white, with, in black, the district letters followed by four numerals. For private use on special occasions a white plate with five numerals (the first two red, the last three black) is issued.

### Coding

The left hand list gives the county letter in use prior to 1964. From 1964 the right hand list has been in use (the first letter of which in general still denotes the county). The Faeroe Islands are still unchanged with two letters.
