VARNISH TRANSFERS

How do you apply English transfers (varnish type) without ruining them?

We mean the old types, generally used until about 1965, when conventional slide off decals and pressure sensitive types came into use in England.

Some of the old types are still in circulation. We run across some now and again. Personally I have never applied one successfully, but then I never knew how.

The following instructions came from Mr. A. Wharton who says " I used to transfer all the Panther motorcycles from 1933 until 1966 when the last Panther was made".

FIXING TRANSFERS WITH VARNISH

- 1. Varnish transfer with quick drying varnish
- 2. Wait while tacky
- 3. Place transfer on article where required:
- 4. Then press on very firm and pull off first paper
- 5. Wet the bottom paper until It slips off
- 6. Clean transfer with Turps, leave to dry
- 7. Varnish again all over

There you have it. It sounds easy enough. But you better practice first, before you try it out on that freshly refinished tank.
