With this wealth of experience to draw upon, and backed by a factory equipped with the most up-to-date machine tools and methods of production, it is not surprising that the modern Matchless has such a unique reputation for outstanding value allied with quality and performance.

The value of a motor cycle is not necessarily proportional to its retail price, and there is no doubt that the ultra efficient methods of manufacture employed in the production of Matchless motor cycles, together with a maintained high output of a comparatively small range of models is greatly to the advantage of Matchless owners. It is therefore not surprising that the demand for Matchless motor cycles is to-day greater than at any time in our long history.



MATCHLESS Clubman

350 c.c. MODEL G3/L and 500 c.c. MODEL G80

ENGINE.-Designed and manufactured throughout in the Matchless Factory to exceptional standards of accuracy, and noted for their mechanical silence, all engines incorporate the following features:

Exceptionally rigid flywheel assembly comprising individually balanced flywheels, two-piece crankpin, triple row Duralumin caged big end bearing, "Lo-ex" piston, heavily finned single port cylinder head and cylinder, downdraught inlet port, chromium plated valve stems, and all moving parts totally enclosed and positively lubricated.

MODEL G3/L.-Bore 69 m.m. Stroke 93 m.m. Capacity 347 c.c.

MODEL G80.-Bore 82.5 m.m. Stroke 93 m.m. Capacity 498 c.c.

LUBRICATION .- Dry sump system with separate oil tank incorporating detachable fabric oil filter. Pressure feed to all moving parts by new large capacity duplex reciprocating plunger pump.

CARBURETTOR .- "Amal" semi-automatic with twist grip throttle control and separate air lever.

GEAR BOX .- Heavyweight four-speed pivot mounted type with enclosed kick-starter, positive stop adjustable foot gear-change, handlebar clutch control and polished end cover.

TRANSMISSION.—Chain throughout. Primary chain enclosed in oil bath case and rear chain protected by deep section guard of new design. Cam type engine shaft shock absorber with special lubricating channel.

STANDS.—Tubular front, spring up rear, and toe-operated central prop stand.

TANKS.-Welded petrol tank of 3 gallons capacity, with chrome winged "M" on each side and two filter type push-on taps. Oil tank of 3 pints capacity of pressed steel welded construction.

FRAME.—Duplex cradle design of brazed construction. Straight front down tube and forged rear fork ends. Pillion footrest lugs on rear chainstays.

HANDLEBARS .- Semi-sports, fully adjustable.

FORKS.—Telescopic hydraulically damped "Teledraulic" of Matchless patented design and manufacture.

BRAKES.—Quickly adjustable internal expanding of extra large diameter on both

SADDLE.-Large spring seat with semi-roll back and three-point mountings of fully adjustable type.


TYRES.—Model G3/L. 19" × 3.25" Dunlop cord on both wheels. Model G80. $19'' \times 3.25''$ front and $19'' \times 3.50''$ rear Dunlop cord.

MUDGUARDS.—Special deep section. Main portion of rear guard quickly detachable to facilitate wheel removal.

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT.-Separate dynamo driven by chain enclosed in oil bath case, with constant voltage control. Large diameter headlamp, and handlebar dipping switch. Readily accessible battery centrally mounted below saddle. Electric horn mounted in front of engine. Ignition by magneto mounted at rear of cylinder and driven by chain running in oil-tight polished cast aluminium chaincase.


FINISH.-Wheel rims, handlebars, filler caps, saddle springs, exhaust system, etc., chromium plated. All enamelled parts three thicknesses of best quality black stove enamel on Bonderized finish. Petrol tank lined in silver. Cylinder heads and barrels stove enamelled.



Designed with this object in mind the 347 c.c. and 498 c.c. Competition models have met with outstanding success both at home and overseas.


The low total weight, outstandingly flexible engine, special steering layout and carefully chosen gear ratios all combine to provide the performance for which the Matchless is justly famous.

For 1948 the Competition Models are still further improved by the provision of a short wheelbase frame, modified hydraulic damping in the Teledraulic forks and many other detail modifications.

The total number of Competition models that we are able to produce is extremely limited, and consequently we are only able to allocate machines to riders who are prepared to give an undertaking that they will use them for the maximum possible number of Competitions.

It is particularly interesting to note that a 350 c.c. Competition Model MATCHLESS ridden by L. A. Ratcliffe won the 1947 British Experts' Trial, and the MATCHLESS Team also won the Team Award in the 1947 Scottish Six Days' Trial.

In the case of machines (a) which have been used for "hiring-out" purposes, or (b) any motorcycle and/or sidecar used for any dirt track, cinder track or grass track racing or competitions (or any competition of any kind within an enclosure for which a charge is made for admission to take part in or view the competition), or (c) machines from which the trade mark, name or manufacturing number has been removed, no guarantee, condition or warranty of any kind is given or is to be implied.

We guarantee, subject to the conditions mentioned below, that all precautions which are usual and reasonable have been taken by us to secure excellence of materials and workmanship, but this guarantee is to extend and be in force for six months only from date of purchase, and damages for which we make ourselves responsible under this guarantee are limited to the free supply of a new part in exchange for the part of the motorcycle, motorcycle combination or sidecar which may have proved defective. We do not undertake to replace or refix, or bear the cost of replacing or refixing such new parts in the motorcycle, motorcycle combination or sidecar. We undertake, subject to the conditions mentioned below, to make good at any time within six months any defects in these respects. As motorcycles, motorcycle combinations and sidecars are easily liable to derangement by neglect, or misuse, this guarantee does not apply to defects caused by wear and tear, misuse or neglect. The term "misuse" shall include amongst others the following acts:—

- 1. The attaching of a sidecar to a motorcycle in such a manner as to cause damage or calculated to render the latter unsafe when ridden.
- 2. The use of a motorcycle or of a motorcycle and sidecar combined, when carrying more persons or a greater weight than that for which the machine was designed by the manufacturers.
- 3. The attaching of a sidecar to a motorcycle by any form of attachment not provided, supplied or approved by us, or to a motorcycle which is not designed for such use. Any motorcycle, motorcycle combination or sidecar sent to us to be plated, enamelled or repaired will be repaired upon the following conditions, i.e., we guarantee that all precautions which are usual and reasonable have been taken by us to secure excellence of materials and workmanship, such guarantee to extend and be in force for three months only from the time such work shall have been executed or until the expiration of the six months above referred to, and this guarantee is in lieu and in exclusion of any common law or statute, warranty or condition, and the damages recoverable are limited to the cost of any further work which may be necessary to amend and make good the work found to be defective.

CONDITIONS OF GUARANTEE

If a defective part should be found in our motorcycles, motorcycle combinations or sidecars, or in any part supplied by owner that he desires to have it repaired or exchanged free of charge under our guarantee, and he must also furnish us at the same time with the number of the machine, the date of the purchase or the date when the alleged defective part was exchanged as the case may be

Failing compliance with the above, such articles will lie here AT THE RISK OF THE OWNER, and this guarantee and any implied guarantee, warranty or condition shall not be enforceable.

We do not guarantee specialities such as tyres, saddles, chains, electrical equipment, lamps, etc., or any component parts supplied to the order of the Purchaser differing from standard specifications, supplied with our motorcycles, motorcycle combinations, sidecars, or otherwise.

 - (c) Top up Battery and check all Lighting Equipment.
 - (d) Clean out Carburettor and adjust mixture.
 - (e) Adjust and lubricate all cables.
 - (f) Grease all Nipples.

- (g) Drain Oil System. Clean filter and replenish.
- (h) Check oil level in front Chain case.
- (i) Top up Gear Box.
- (j) Test machine on road.
