

## THE "SPORTS 250" MODEL 34/F.

## SPECIFICATION.

with down-draught inlet port, enclosed overhead-valve gear, "Lo-ex" alloy piston, roller big end bearing, double camphaft timing gear running in oilbath, decompressor to ensure easy starting, heavily finned cylinder and cylinder head, and all other latest features to ensure high power output and complete reliability.

Bore 62.5 m.m. Stroke 80 m.m. Capacity 246 c.c.

A.C.U. rating 2.46 h.p.

LUBRICATION. "Marchess" dry sump system, oil pressure fed to all working parts, including cylinder wall, big end bearing, mainshaft bearing and camshaft bearing, by duplex horizontal reciprocating rotary plunger pump. Surplus oil is sucked from the crankcase sump and returned to oil tank through a fabric filter which entirely removes all impurities. The filter is readily detachable for cleaning. Cycle parts lubricated by grease gun throughout.

GEARBOX. Three-speed pivot-mounted gearbox with latest type clutch and kickstarter. Hand gear change.

Gear ratios 6.3, 10.1, and 19 to 1.

TRANSMISSION. By chain throughout; front chain enclosed in oil-bath chaincase, rear chain protected by adequate guard, with back panel.

CARBURETTER. Two-lever semi-automatic "AMAL" carburetter with horizontal mixing chamber. Twist grip

control for throttle.

EXHAUST SYSTEM. Large diameter exhaust pipe with tubular silencer. Low pipe as illustrated, or upswept competition exhaust pipe can be supplied at option without extra charge.

STAND. Spring-up centre prop stand.

TANKS. Bulbous saddle tank for petrol, made of pressed steel and welded throughout; capacity a gallons. Separate pressed steel oil tank under saddle; capacity a pints.

FRAME. Latest type duplex crudle frame with twin down tubes.

SPRING FORKS. Tubular spring forks of graceful and stordy design with adjustable shock absorbers.

BRAKES. Internal expanding brakes on both wheels.

HANDLEBARS. tin. diameter "clean" handlebars, adjustable for angle and with integral control fittings; twist grip control for throttle, level control for ignition and air, clutch lever on left handlebar, front brake lever on right handlebar.

KNEEGRIPS. Large rubber kneegrips included in specification.

MUDGUARDS. Deep section mudguards providing ample protection and handsome appearance. Rear mudguard detachable for tyre repairs. Chromium-edged mudguards exactly as used on the MATCHLESS "SPORTS 500" can be supplied, if required, at an extra charge of which includes a separate front wheel stand.

SADDLE. "Lycert" Aero spring seat.

TYRES. 26in. x 3.35in. "FIRESTONE" Cord.

LUGGAGE CARRIER. Detachable luggage carrier can be supplied at an extra charge of

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT. "Lucas" six-volt electric lighting and coil ignition system. Large size
dynamo giving 30 watts output rigidly mounted on
engine plates and driven direct from crankshaft by
roller chain enclosed in main oil-bath chaincase. Accessible adjustment provided for chain tension. Contoct breaker built into engine timing case. Lighting
equipment consists of 6in. diameter head-lamp with
purking light and with dimming switch on handlebar,
Lucas tail lamp mounted on rear number plate. The
switch, ammeter and warning light showing when
ignition is switched on, are mounted in the back of
the head-lamp. Extra large battery carried on special
platform beneath saddle.


FINISH. Petrol tank finished in glossy black enamel with gold lines and chromium-plated embossed "M" on each side. Frame, handlebars, etc., stove-enamelled black after special anti-rust process. All the usual bright parts heavily chromium-plated.

MAXIMUM SPEED. 65-70 miles per hour.

TAX. Annual Tax in Great Britain per annum.

That no item of the specification has been sacrificed is evident from the fact that the machine is fitted with 25m. x 3.25m. Tyres, while the down-draught inlet port and the up-to-date cylinder head design show that the engine incorporates the very latest practice and can be depended upon to give its high power output for long periods without
