347 c.c. SINGLE PORT O.H.V. SINGLE CYLINDER WITH FULL 'TELEDRAULIC' SUSPENSION



SPECIFICATION

The ourstandingly successful A.J.S. Competition Models 16MC and 18C are supplemented for the 1951 season by the addition of the Models 16MCS and 18CS. These two new models are fitted with specially strengthened frames incorporating full Teledraulic suspension and designed for successful participation in high speed cross country events.

The Competition Models differ from the specification published on page 10 in the following respects: High ground clearance, 53" wheelbase rigid frames, 3.00" x 21" front and 4.00" x 19" rear wheels, polished L.A. mudguards, 21 gallon fuel tank, heavily finned L.A. cylinder and cylinder head, cylinder head retained by through bolts from crankcase, crankcase shield, internally mounted footrests, folding kick-starter, racing type magneto etc. B.A. type gear box on Spring Frame Models.

OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT

Standard or wide ratio gears, standard rear wheel, 3 gallon fuel tank.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS

Competition tyres, high compression piston, racing cams, exhaust pipe extension, electrical equipment.




SPECIFICATION

The Model 7R has been designed for participation in International Races under F.I.M. regulations, and in this connection it has been outstandingly successful. Many modifications and improvements have been made since this model was first introduced, and the number of machines of this type entered in important Road Races is the best possible indication of the model 7R's efficiency and popularity.

348 c.c. O.H.C. Single-cylinder. 74 m.m. bore x 81 m.m. stroke: Magnesium alloy crankcase, timing case, rocker box etc., L.A. Cylinder head with shrunk in bronze exhaust valve seat and iron inlet valve seat, chain driven camshaft, duplex overlapping hairpin valve springs, eccentric spindle valve adjustment, twin gear type oil pumps circulating 26 gallons per hour at 7.000 R.P.M: duplex cradle frame of welded construction with full front and rear Teledraulic oil damped suspension, L.A. tanks, L.A. wheel rims, 21" x 3.00" front and 20" x 3.25" rear tyres; 8" brakes, T.T. close ratio 4-speed gear box, Smith rev. counter, Total weight 298 lbs.

Supplied with 9.1 compression ratio piston for use on 80 octane International fuel. 11.1 and 13.1 compression ratio pistons available for 50/50 Petrol Benzol and Alcohol fuels if required.

GENERAL SPECIFICATION ALL MODELS

ENGINE - Single Cylinder.

High efficiency single port O.H.V. all moving parts totally enclosed and positively lubricated, robust flywheel assembly incorporating triple row Duralumin caged roller big end bearing and two-piece crankpin supported by twin ball races on drive side, and plain bronze bearing on timing side, heavily finned L.A. cylinder head with cast in valve seats, tipped valves, duplex hairpin valve springs, non-slap wire wound piston, dry sump lubrication, duplex plunger oil pump, Lucas magneto chain-driven from inlet cam wheel, separate dynamo chain-driven from driving side mainshaft, Amal semi-automatic carburettor.

bearing crankshaft, spherical crankcase with separate centre bearing support, separate L.A. cylinder heads and cast iron cylinders. MUDGUARDS. Ribbed steel of deep section with tubular stays. Valanced rear guard on Spring Frame and "Springtwin" Models.

SADDLE. Large spring seat with semi roll back and adjustable three point mounting.

TRANSMISSION Primary chain and engine shaft shock absorber enclosed in oil bath case. Rear chain protected by efficient deep guard.

No such Dealer is authorised to transact any business, give any warranty, make any representation, or incur any liability on our behalf.

GUARANTEE

We give the following guarantee with our motorcycles, motorcycle combinations and sidecars, which is given in place of any implied conditions, warranties or liabilities whatsoever, statutory or otherwise, all such implied conditions, warranties and liabilities being in all cases excluded. Any statement, description, condition or representation contained in any catalogue, advertisement, leaflet or other publication shall not be construed as enlarging, varying or overriding this guarantee. In the case of machines (a) which have been used for "hirring-out" purposes, or (b) any motorcycle and/or sidecar used for any dirt track, cinder track or grass track racing or competitions (or any competition of any kind within an enclosure for which a charge is made for admission to take part in or view the competition), or (c) machines from which the trade mark, name or manufacturing number has been removed, no guarantee, condition or warranty of any kind is given or is to be implied.

We guarantee, subject to the conditions mentioned below, that all precautions which are usual and reasonable have been taken by us to secure excellence of materials and workmanship, but this guarantee is to extend and be in force for six months only from date of purchase, and damages for which we make ourselves responsible under this guarantee are limited to the free supply of a new part in exchange for the part of the motorcycle, motorcycle combination or sidecar which may have proved defective. We do not undertake to replace or refix, or bear the cost of replacing or refixing such new parts in the motorcycle, motorcycle combination or sidecar. We undertake subject to the conditions mentioned below, to make good at any time within six months any defects in these respects. As motorcycles, motorcycle combinations and sidecars are easily liable to derangement by neglect, or misuse, this guarantee does not apply to defects caused by wear and tear, misuse or neglect. The term "misuse" shall include amongst others the following acts:—

- The attaching of a sidecar to a motorcycle in such a manner as to cause damage or calculated to render the latter unsafe when ridden.
- The use of a motorcycle or of a motorcycle and sidecar combined, when carrying more persons or a greater weight than that for which the machine was designed by the manufacturers.

The attaching of a sidecar to a motorcycle by any form of attachment not provided, supplied or approved by us, or to a motorcycle which is not designed for such use

Any motorcycle, motorcycle combination or sidecar sent to us to be plated, enamelled or repaired will be repaired upon the following conditions, i.e., we guarantee that all precautions which are usual and reasonable have been taken by us to secure excellence of materials and workmanship, such guarantee to extend and be in force for three months only from the time such work shall have been executed or until the expiration of the six months above referred to, and this guarantee is in lieu and in exclusion of any common law or statute, warranty or condition, and the damages recoverable are limited to the cost of any further work which may be necessary to amend and make good the work found to be defective.

CONDITIONS OF GUARANTEE

If a defective part should be found in our motorcycles, motorcycle combinations or sidecars, or in any part supplied by way of exchange before referred to, it must be sent to us CARRIAGE PAID, and accompanied by an intimation from the owner that he desires to have it repaired or exchanged free of charge under our guarantee, and he must also furnish us at the same time with the number of the machine, the date of the purchase, or the date when the alleged defective part was exchanged, as the case may be.

Failing compliance with the above, such articles will lie here AT THE RISK OF THE OWNER, and this guarantee and any implied guarantee, warranty or condition shall not be enforceable. We do not guarantee specialities such as tyres, saddles, chains, electrical equipment, lamps, etc., or any component parts supplied to the order of the purchaser differing from standard specification, supplied with our motorcycles, motorcycle combinations, sidecars or otherwise.
