



The ideal mount for high average speeds over long distances








## Specification

The Competition Models vary from the standard specification in the following respects:—53" wheelbase, high ground clearance rigid frames, 21 gall. tank, polished aluminium mudguards, 3.00" × 21" front and 4.00" x 19" rear wheels and Dunlop Trials tyres, special footrests, crankcase shield, folding kickstarter, waterproof Competition magneto, wide ratio gears on Rigid models, low overall weight assisted by Light Alloy cylinder and cylinder head attached to crankcase by through bolts.

OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT Standard or wide ratio gears, 3 gall, fuel tank, standard rear wheel.

#### OPTIONAL EXTRAS

High compression piston, racing cams, exhaust pipe extension, Competition tyres, electrical equipment with quickly detachable headlamp.



We guarante subject to the conditions mentioned below, that all precautions which are sumally and reasonable flave been glaken by, as to secure excellence of the months and workmanship, but this guarantee is to extend and be in force for months only from date of purchase, and damages for which we make ouncives expossible under this guarantee are limited to the free-supply of a new part in exchange for the part of the motorcycle, monorcycle contribution or sidecat which may have proved defective. We do not undertake to replace or refix, or bear-the most of replacing or refixing such new parts in the motorcycle, motorcycle, combination or sidecat. We undertake sublect to the conditions mentioned below, to make good at any time within six months any defects in these respects. #### SINGLE CYLINDER MODELS

of GNE, 350 c.c. Models: 69 m.m. Bore 93 m.m. Stroke, 347 c.c. Capacity, 500 c.c. Models: 82.5 m.m. Bore 93 m.m. Stroke, 498 c.c. Capacity.

Both engines are of the high efficiency O.H.V. Single port type incorporating the following features:

Die cast Light Alloy cylinder head with totally enclosed and positively lubricated valve gear operated by Duralumin pushrods, built up rockers and overiapping duplex hairpin valve springs, extremely rigid fully balanced flywheel assembly, woopiece crankpin, triple row caged roller big end bearing, twin ball race drive side and bronze timing side main bearings, low clearance wire-wound piston, duplex rotary reciprocating oil pump and full dry sump lubrication system twin cam wheels, chain-driven Lucas magneto and semi-automatic Amai carburettor.

FRAME—RIGID. Heavy gauge duplex cradle of brazed construction with malleable lugs, forged fork ends, left and right fitting sidecar lugs and pillion footrest lugs. Front, rear and side stands.

FRAME—SPRING. Exceptionally robust swinging arm pivoting in self-lubricating bronze bushes. Twin Teledraulic oil damped suspension units mounted on flexible rubber bushes. Integral footrest lugs; front, centre and side stands.

GHAR BOX. Entirely new heavyweight 4-speed racing type of compact design. Multi-plate clutch, fully enclosed positive stap foot-operated gear change. Internal ratios 2.6, 1.7 and 1.3 times top sear.

FORKS. Oil damped self-lubricating Teledraulic incorporating forged steel steering crown and improved handlebar mounting casting.

SRAKES. 7" internal expanding with cast drums and finger and shim adjustment.

WHERLS AND PURES. Fabricated steel hubs, adjustable caged taper roller bearings, heavy-gauge spokes. Dunlop 3.25° × 19° tyres on 350° c.c. Models; 3.25° × 19° front and 3.50° × 19° rear tyres on 500° c.c. Models.

HANDLEBARS AND CONTROLS. Integral clutch and ignition & front brake and air controls mounted on fully adjustable handlebars. Quick action twist grip throttle, headlamp dipper switch and electric horn button.

"N.S. Of welded steel construction and fitted with quick action filler caps. Twin filter petrol taps and detachable fabric oil filter. Fuel capacity: 3 gallons. Oil capacity: 4 pints. "Springtwin": 4 agilons.

FULL SILE SUBS. Deep section ribbed steel with rubular stays. Valanced rear guard on all Spring Frame Models.

SOURCE. Spring top with fully adjustable 3-point mounting.

PT-088-01881ON. Primary and rear drive by roller chain. Oil bath primary chain-case and cam type engine shaft shock absorber. Efficient deep section rear chainguard.

MARKETTE CALL SEQUED VICTOR. 32-watt chain-driven dynamo. Large diameter headlamp, car type rear light, voltage control unit and electric horn.

#### MODEL 20 "SPRINGTWIN"

The "Springtwin" specification is identical to the single cylinder models with the exception of the engine, which is of special interest, and dealt with separately as tollows:

Bore: 66 m.m. Stroke: 72.8 m.m. Capacity: 498 c.c.

Iron Alloy fully balanced 3 bearing crankshart, spherical crankcase, separate cylinders and light alloy cylinder heads, full dry sump lubrication by twin large capacity gear pumps with positive lubrication to all moving parts and no external engine oil pipes.

Eccentric spindle O.H.V. adjustment, Duralumin pushrods, twin gear-driven camshafts, forged light alloy connecting rods with Vandervell big end bearings, wire-wound pistons, gear-driven flange mounted magneto and 45-watt dynamo, semi-automatic Amal carburettor, detacnable fabric crankcase oil filter.
