



1. PARTS INFORMATION

The Spare Parts Books for a number of years have been used to prepare the information presented here.

LIMITATIONS

There are no detailed illustrations of the assembly or the individual parts in the Spare Parts books of this time. After 1932 they did improve but usually these were only generic images to demonstrate what the part might look like – they don't allow positive identification of specific parts by Part Number and illustration.




Figure 1: View of the general layout of the Steering Damper.

In all tables used to show Part information in this document there are a few "rules" to follow. The Spare Parts Books use different names for the same or similar items across the years. There are also at least 5 different part numbering systems used with many of the same parts being used across the different systems. To allow searching of my Parts Database there are conventions I have used to "normalise" the information. This is shown in Figure 2.

Parts Book Name	This is the name from the Spare Parts Book;
Part No. To Use	This is the latest Part Number assigned to this part across the different
	systems;
Parts Book Name	This is the name or description of the part as listed in the Spare Parts
	Book;
Name Common	This is a representative name for the same or similar Part Number
	situation usage. It is usually from a later Parts Book where a more solid
	"system" had developed for naming the parts.
