Dynamo Sprocket locking system Received from Don Littleford via Rick:

Rick.

I refer to recent discussions in the group regarding the system that holds the dynamo sprocket in place . Could you include the following details in the archives .

Attached are photos of the lock washer, nut and spring clip, and also in the installed position.

The special lock washer has internal serrations that grab the nut's hex edges. The lock washer also has 2 arms turned down at the ends that fit into the slots on the sprocket.

The plain washer and nut are tightened on the dynamo shaft. The lock washer is then placed over the nut with the arms engaging the sprocket slots. The nut has a groove cut into it, and the lock ring is fitted into the groove. It holds the lock washer on the nut. Could you include the details in the archive.
