# 1959 A.J.S. MOTOR CYCLES

With sixteen distinct and highly attractive Models listed for the 1959 Season, it is difficult to provide the essential details in the space available in our usual annual letter and consequently, tabulated information has been compiled and this is attached.

Ranging from the high performance 250cc. Model-14 to the new and extremely potent 650cc. Twins, the 1959 Programme covers every conceivable requirement.

The road Singles have been greatly improved by the adoption of new deep section one-piece mudguards of very modern design, and in addition to these new mudguards, all road Twins are fitted with redesigned petrol tanks of 4½ gallon capacity. High output A-C generators are fitted to 500cc. and 650cc. standard Twins and separate dynamos and magneto ignition to deLuxe Twins.

Tabulated details of the coloured finishes that are available are also provided but the traditional black and gold finish is retained as standard for all normal Models.

The deLuxe Twins are fitted with quickly detachable rear wheels and chromium plated tank panels, but both items are available for other Models as optional extras.

## A.J.S. 1959 PROGRAMME (S.L.531) - continued:

A Moto-Cross version of the Model-14 is introduced, the 350cc. Trials Model is now much lighter and shorter and the 350cc. and 500cc. Moto-Cross Models are even faster than in 1958.

The extremely successful Racing Model 7R continues, but as usual, this design will be the subject of intensive development work during the Winter months.

As certain Model numbers have been brought up to date by the deletion of letters that are now obsolete, both current and past numbers are quoted in the attached programme and specification information.

Full details of 1959 Models will appear in the technical Press on 18th September, and prices will be advised at an early date.

Preparations for 1959 Model production are well advanced and the ability of Dealers and Distributors to provide early details of their immediate needs will enable all concerned to get off to a good start.

May we take this opportunity of thanking our many trade friends for their loyal support during 1958 and trust that our efforts to meet their needs result in an even more successful 1959 Season.
